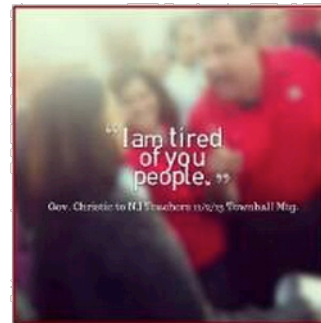

A critical message for all NJ Teachers & Public School Employees:

After bragging that CH 78 (2011) would “fix” the pension problem, Gov. Christie is back in court arguing that this same law is now unconstitutional.

His new “solution”?

- A Constitutional Amendment that will allow the state to cut pension benefits for all public workers—even if you’ve already earned them.
- Freeze the current pension and create a “cash balance” hybrid plan going forward.
- Shift the state’s responsibility for funding to local employers, and decrease retirement benefits.
- Push billions in additional health care costs onto school employees—while decreasing health care benefits.
- Transfer the money for both the old (frozen) pension and the new hybrid plan to “employee entities” (NJEA) so that school employees bear the risks of these plans going forward.
